## "Questions"

Martin Luther held informal classes around his supper table. Students at the university in his hometown of Wittenberg were often invited to join Luther and his family for their evening meal. "Table Talk" is a collection of informal teaching sessions shared by Dr. Luther.

There is one report of a student who asked one question after another one evening. The questions began to weary Professor Luther. Finally, the student asked what God was doing before he created the world. Luther replied that he was creating hell for people who asked too many questions.

Martin Luther knew about asking questions. He did it all the time. In fact, as a young man, his questions plagued him. His inability to find answers to his questions would often shake his faith and create a living hell for him.

When Luther was a monk in the monastery, his "spiritual father" was a man named Johan Staupitz. Martin Luther tested Father Staupitz' patience with his questions just like others would do to Luther. But Johan Staupitz' most memorable bit of advice to Luther and his questioning had nothing to do with hell. Instead his advice was to "focus on what you know, not on what you don't know."

We all have questions. Some have simple answers. Some cannot be answered, at least not with any earthly wisdom. It's frustrating, and perhaps even faith threatening, to be left with unanswered questions. So we need to focus on what we do know.

Here are three things we do know:

God created the world.

God loved the world so much he gave his only Son so that all people could know forgiveness and never ending life in his love.

God sent his Holy Spirit into this world so that we can know and believe in his love.  
(Happy Pentecost!)

Next time you have questions, it's okay to work hard at finding answers. But when answers can't be found, focus on what you know. And if the questions you can't answer really bother you, talk to Pastor Stuart.



## **PERSONAL CARE KITS**

Each kit includes:

One light- or medium-weight bath-size towel (approx. 52” X 27”), dark color recommended  
Two bath-size bars (4 to 5 oz.) of soap, any brand, in original wrapping  
One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging  
One sturdy comb  
One metal nail clippers

## *FROM THE DESK OF NURSE MARSHA:*

Happy Spring! I am always truly amazed at God's artistry every Spring and how He wakes our area of the world up! It's a way of having a fresh start and truly seeing His many blessings. Speaking of fresh starts... May is "Employee Health and Fitness Month" so when I was asked by the Peaceful Beginnings staff to be the designated weigh in person and weight management helper for their "Biggest Loser" competition, I decided this is a fresh start and also a way to share God's love. I weigh in 10 people(including Nurse Marsha☺)once per week for 8 weeks and give each one of them body, mind and spirit tips on how to lose weight, increase health and also use humor along the way to keep them motivated. I send them a weekly encouragement email tip with ideas for them on how to keep on track.

One tip sheet I gave them recently is from "Health Notes" by Marla Lichtsinn, RN, MPA, FCN, Parish Nurse titled "Lean Budget, Healthy Diet". Here's a brief overview of the basics of a healthy diet and a few tips that won't break your budget (in my words):

\*Stop thinking "DIET" and think "lifestyle change"...it doesn't mean you are punishing yourself by eating healthy. In fact a good diet is simply a plan for eating a variety of foods that provide you with the right nutrients to keep healthy. The fringe benefit is having an increase in energy so you can increase your exercise and hopefully lose the weight that you may desire.

\*Choose fruits and vegetables in abundance-lots of them! Buy the ones in season and also at the local farmer's market. Plant a small garden and reap what you sow! Take one day each week to plan your healthy meals, chop up each fruit/vegetable as necessary and then pack your lunches-easy and cost effective☺

\*Include calcium-low or nonfat dairy foods such as low fat milk, yogurt, cottage cheese. Read the food labels to make sure of the contents and if it's truly "low fat". Also, valuable calcium is in spinach, kale, collard greens and turnip greens.

\*Portion size is IMPORTANT- know what a single portion looks like (3 oz of meat is the size of a deck of cards)-get out your measuring cups and spoons, count the number of chips etc. Keep in mind that your body needs a balance of nutrients so change it up and eat different types of food.

\*Get 7-8 hours of rest/sleep a day (it's free☺)-this will help you lose weight and help you snack less. I found a funny quote from an unknown author in the May/June '12 Joyful Noiseletter that made me laugh "Being overweight just snacks up on you"☺

Lastly...one of our parishioners shared her information about "Loseit.com". It's a way for you to track your food intake and exercise-fun and very useful tip!

We are thankful for their time and effort in providing this valuable service to the children and families of Peaceful Beginnings.

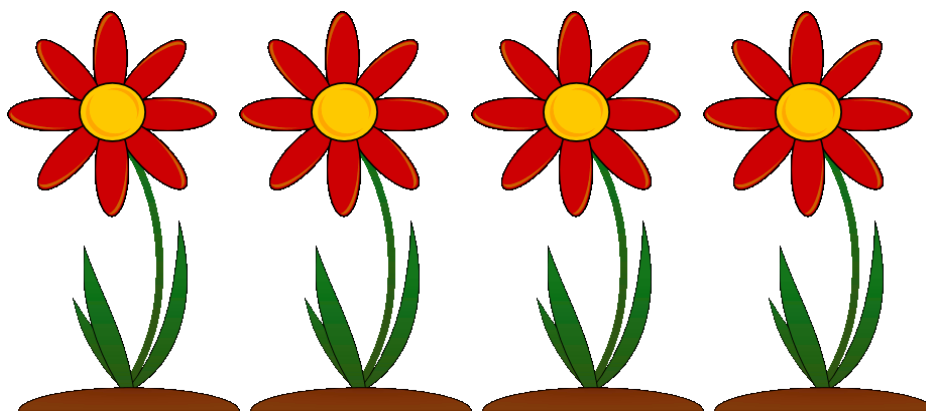
